Voluntary Water Restrictions in Effect

Harris County MUD No. 102 (the District) has activated **Voluntary Water Restrictions** until further notice. The District uses drought restrictions to conserve the available water supply and protect the integrity of water supply facilities, and minimize the adverse impacts of water supply shortage or other water supply emergency conditions. Stage One Restrictions call for action of all customers as follows:

- Please limit all outdoor water use, including lawn and garden watering, window washing and car washing to certain days of the week depending on your address:

Watering Schedule

Last digit of street address	Watering Days
<i>Odd</i>	<i>Tuesdays and Saturdays</i>
<i>Even</i>	<i>Wednesdays and Sundays</i>
<i>No street address: north and west side of street</i>	<i>Wednesdays and Sundays</i>
<i>No street address: south and east side of street</i>	<i>Tuesdays and Saturdays</i>
<i>Green belts, esplanades and sports fields irrigation</i>	<i>Mondays and Fridays</i>

- Please adhere to the following hours for OUTDOOR water use:

Daytime	Night-time
<i>10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.</i>	<i>12:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.</i>

- Reduce water consumption by any means available. Reprogram irrigation controllers to the above schedule; repair leaking toilets and faucets; do not run water while brushing teeth; take shorter showers; run dishwashers and washing machines only when full.
