Unacceptable Items

Plastic bags, Styrofoam, Soiled Pizza Boxes, Coat Hangers, Paint & Solvent Containers, Light Bulbs, Mirrors, Windows, Dishes & Cups, Wet/Soiled Paper, Paper Towels, Facial & Toilet Tissue, Disposable Plates & Cups, Milk & Juice Cartons (wax-board containers)

REMINDERS FOR SUCCESSFUL RECYCLING EFFORTS

Rinse all food and beverage containers. This prevents odors and attraction of insects.

Crush or flatten both plastic beverage bottles and cans. This saves space in your container.

Utilize an additional waste container clearly marked RECYCLE, for containment of additional material.

Use CLEAR bags ONLY for containing recyclables.

Allow extra space separation between your trash and your recyclables containers.

Please flatten boxes and place only paper boxes within paper boxes.

Large cardboard boxes must be cut into sections smaller than 24 x 24 inches.

****Utilize the paper recovery containers at your local schools for large amounts of waste paper and boxes.**** You help the environment, your local school and save the storage space for your normal recyclables.

Paper products contaminated with food, grease and oils are NOT recyclable!

Styrofoam products and packaging material are NOT recyclable from the home.

If the crew cannot identify the material as recoverable it will be treated as trash.

Only glass food and beverage containers should be placed out for recycling.

The RECYCLE container provided by WCA is for the containment of RECYCLABLES ONLY!
