TRASH COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Scheduled trash collection days are: **MONDAY AND THURSDAY**.
- All trash must be located at the **CURB** by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection days. Residents in the townhome sections will have their trash serviced at the trash bin area by the carport.
- Trash must be contained in either trash containers or trash bags not exceeding 40-gallons or 40-pounds in weight when fully utilized. (Trash is defined as garbage generated from inside the house, exclusive of any construction or remodeling debris). Trash dropped during the collection process will be picked up by the crew.
- Tree limbs, shrubs, brush trimmings and small amounts of fence pickets must be neatly stacked at the curb. Limbs or branches must be less than 3 inches in diameter, in lengths no greater than 4-feet long. Small debris shall be bagged or containerized within the size and weight limits previously stated above.
- Bulky waste/heavy items such as appliances, furniture, carpet (up to 1 room, rolled up 4-feet wide and less than 40-pounds) and cardboard boxes (flattened) must be located at the curb area of each residence and will be collected on either scheduled collection day.
- By Federal Law, refrigerators and freezers or any other items containing Freon must be drained of Freon and have an accompanying bill to validate such service was performed.
- Items **excluded** from collection and will not be collected are paint, dirt, rocks, bricks, concrete, tires, batteries, motor oil, cooking oil, liquids, flammable liquids, waste generated by a private contractor(s) or any materials or items deemed hazardous materials. Any spillage or leakage of excluded liquids above, not visible to crew prior to and upon collection, shall be the responsibility of the resident.
- Holidays: If the collection day falls on any of the following observed holidays, no collection service will be provided that day; scheduled service will be resumed on the next regularly scheduled collection day. WCA observes the following holidays: **New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day**
- Missed collection? Please contact customer service at the number provided below. Late set outs will be collected on the next scheduled collection day. WCA will provide collection within 24 hours of notice should the missed collection be our error.

RECYCLING COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Scheduled Recycling collection day is: **MONDAY**.
- Your recyclable material must be located at the **CURB** by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day. Residents in the townhome sections will have their recycling serviced at the trash bin area by the carport.
- Items may be comingled within the Bin provided by WCA. The Bin remains the property of WCA and should the residence be vacated please leave the Bin for the next resident.
- Recyclable items exceeding the capacity of the Bin maybe contained in a resident provided waste container or clear plastic bag clearly marked as recyclables and placed next to the WCA Bin.
- Acceptable items for recycling:

Paper: Newsprint, magazines, catalogs, junk mail and envelopes, copy paper, file folders, paper grocery bags, telephone books, greeting cards.

Cardboard such as cereal boxes, shoe boxes, soda and beer boxes and storage/moving boxes.

Glass containers: Post consumer food and juice containers, beer and soda bottles.

Plastic containers: Post consumer food, juice, soda, water, shampoo bottles. Plastic items must contain the international recycling code 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7. **Plastic grocery type bags and Styrofoam are excluded.**

Steel and aluminum containers: Beer, soda, tuna, vegetable, juice, pet food and similar metal containers are acceptable.

Unacceptable or excluded items include: Soiled food packaging, paper towels, paint or solvent containers, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramic glass plates or dishes, coat hangers and wrapping paper. Should you have a question regarding whether an item is acceptable for recycling you may contact customer service.
