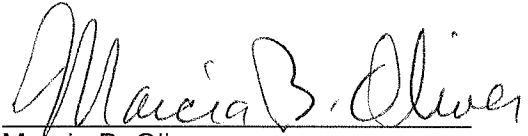
TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 102 OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 102 will hold a **special meeting**, open to the public, on **MONDAY, 19 MAY 2014**, at **6:00 p.m.** at **15300 Falmouth**, Houston, Texas, within the boundaries of the District, to consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Minutes of the meeting of 28 April 2014;
2. Consider comments from District residents;
3. Security Report;
4. Solid Waste Collection Report (contract expires 4/30/19; 60-day notice);
5. Report of the Tax Assessor/Collector, including:
  - (a) approve payments from the District's tax account;
  - (b) review and authorize actions for the collection of delinquent taxes, including possible termination of service;
6. Operator's Report, including:
  - (a) operation of the District's facilities;
  - (b) discuss and authorize any repairs or other work by the Operator deemed necessary;
  - (c) report regarding water accountability;
  - (d) report regarding status of sanitary sewer overflows, permit violations, and/or insurance claims;
  - (e) authorize action against delinquent accounts, including termination of service;
  - (f) status of replacement of Lift Pump 2 at Lift Station 2 and authorize actions deemed necessary (Neil Technical Services, Corp.);
  - (g) discuss condition of sanitary sewer lines at 6448 Alisa and 15522 Baxter and authorize actions deemed necessary, including possible point repairs;
  - (h) status of repairs to fire hydrants;
  - (i) discuss proposed customer education initiative (proper disposal of grease and rags);
  - (j) discuss alternative root removal products for cleaning sanitary sewer lines (Root-X vs. foam products);

7. Engineer's Report, including:
  - (a) status of contract for Water Plant No. 2 expansion and improvements (W. W. Payton Corp.), and authorize actions deemed necessary, including approval of pay estimates and change orders, as needed;
  - (b) review proposal to investigate condition of storm sewer lines in Langham Creek Colony;
  - (c) report regarding maintenance of Concord Colony, Section Two and Waldron Estates detention facilities;
  - (d) status of TCEQ Sanitary Sewer Overflow Initiative;
8. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
  - (a) authorize payment of the District's bills;
  - (b) review investments in the District's accounts;
  - (c) review Depository Pledge Report;
  - (d) review and approve Amended and Restated Agreement for Bookkeeping Services;
9. New business, including status of annual unclaimed property reports and escheat of funds to State of Texas (Bookkeeper and Tax Assessor/Collector);
10. Old business, including:
  - (a) status of surface water issues related to West Harris County Regional Water Authority;
  - (b) discuss power supply issues (P3);
  - (c) status of issues related to District's web site;
  - (d) discuss landscaping issues, and authorize actions deemed necessary,;
11. Attorney's Report, including:
  - (a) discuss legal action threatened by Al Perez for injuries sustained on 4/9/14 near Water Plant No. 1;
  - (b) discuss revisions requested by TWDB to Utility Profile for Water Conservation Plan, and authorize actions deemed necessary, including possible approval of updated Plan;
12. Executive session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code, if necessary, to discuss matters relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security;
13. Action on matters discussed in executive session;
14. Schedule future meetings as required; and
