TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 102 OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 102 will hold a **regular meeting**, open to the public, at **6:00 p.m.** on **MONDAY, 26 MARCH 2018**, at **15300 Falmouth, Harris County, Texas**, inside the boundaries of the District, to consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Consider comments and questions from District residents (3 minute limit);
2. Minutes of the meeting of 26 February 2018;
3. Security Report (Harris County Sheriff's Department);
4. Solid Waste Collection Report (contract expires 4/30/19; 60-day notice), including review proposals for collection of bulk residential construction debris;
5. Report of the Tax Assessor/Collector, including:
  - (a) approve payments from the District's tax account;
  - (b) review and authorize actions for the collection of delinquent taxes, including possible termination of service;
6. Operator's Report, including:
  - (a) operation of the District's facilities;
  - (b) discuss and authorize any repairs or other work by the Operator deemed necessary;
  - (c) report regarding status of sanitary sewer overflows, permit violations, and/or insurance claims;
  - (d) report regarding water accountability;
  - (e) discuss status of billing to District customers affected by Hurricane Harvey flooding event and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (f) authorize actions related to Hurricane Harvey flooding event, including requests for public assistance to FEMA;
  - (g) status of repairs relating to 18 April 2016 flooding event, including status of Request for Public Assistance filed with FEMA;
  - (h) authorize action against delinquent accounts, including termination of service;
  - (i) review Annual Fire Hydrant Report and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (j) discuss annual report to TWDB regarding Water Conservation Plan (due 5/1/18), and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (k) discuss annual report to TWDB regarding water loss audit (pursuant to HB 857 [2014] - due 5/1/18), and authorize actions deemed necessary;
7. Engineer's Report, including:
  - (a) report regarding maintenance of Concord Colony, Section Two and Waldron Estates detention facilities, including renewal of Storm Water Quality permits;
  - (b) status of Bond Application Report (Series 2018 Bonds);
  - (c) status of TCEQ Sanitary Sewer Overflow Initiative and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (d) status of plans for conversion of WWTP disinfection system;
  - (e) status of plans for flood mitigation at sanitary sewer lift stations;
  - (f) discuss 10-year inspection of cleaning and rehabilitation of sanitary sewer system in Area B – Phase 1);

- (g) discuss condition of hydropneumatic tanks (Water Plant No. 1) and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (h) requests for service, including:
    - (1) Redeemed Christian Church of God – House of David;
    - (2) 2.0-acre tract on Addicks Satsuma Road (Seven Star Plus, Inc.);
  - (i) discuss and authorize actions related to damages caused by Hurricane Harvey;
8. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
- (a) authorize payment of the District's bills;
  - (b) review investments in the District's accounts;
  - (c) review Depository Pledge Report;
  - (d) review and possibly approve Depository Pledge Agreement (Spirit of Texas Bank);
9. New business, including:
- (a) approve Resolution Indemnifying directors for deductible on Directors & Officers liability insurance policy;
  - (b) annual review of Conflicts Disclosure Statements;
  - (c) authorize mailing of notice regarding Drought Contingency Plan;
10. Old business, including:
- (a) discuss proposed sale of Series 2018 Bonds and authorize actions deemed necessary;
  - (b) status of request to District consultants for annual insurance certificates;
  - (c) status of Agreement for Out-of-District Service to 2-acre tract on Addicks-Satsuma Road (Seven Star Plus, Inc.);
  - (d) status of surface water issues related to West Harris County Regional Water Authority;
  - (e) discuss power supply issues (P3);
  - (f) status of issues related to District's web site, including review of content;
  - (g) discuss landscaping issues, including status of tree pruning (Arbor Care, Inc.);
11. Attorney's Report, including status of continuing disclosure filing for the District (due 3/30/18);
12. Executive session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code, if necessary, to discuss matters relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security;
13. Action on matters discussed in executive session;
14. Schedule future meetings as required; and
15. Discuss items to be placed on future meeting agendas.
